Shorter Catechism:

**Question 58:** *What is required in the fourth commandment?*

**Answer 58:** *The fourth commandment requires the keeping holy to God such times as He has appointed in His word; expressly one whole day in seven, to be a holy Sabbath to himself.*

**Genesis 2:2-3** - By the seventh day God had finished the work he had been doing; so on the seventh day he rested from all his work. <sup>3</sup> Then God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it he rested from all the work of creating that he had done.

Numbers 15:32-36 (NIV)  
Penalty for Violating the Sabbath

<sup>32</sup> While the Israelites were in the wilderness, a man was found gathering wood on the Sabbath day.

<sup>33</sup> Those who found him gathering wood brought him to Moses and Aaron and the whole assembly,

<sup>34</sup> and they kept him in custody, because it was not clear what should be done to him.

<sup>35</sup> Then the LORD said to Moses, “The man must die. The whole assembly must stone him outside the camp.”

<sup>36</sup> So the assembly took him outside the camp and stoned him to death, as the LORD commanded Moses.
