### *Philippians 1:20-26*

<sup>20</sup> I eagerly expect and hope that I will in no way be ashamed, but will have sufficient courage so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death.

<sup>21</sup> For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.

<sup>22</sup> If I am to go on living in the body, this will mean fruitful labor for me. Yet what shall I choose? I do not know!

<sup>23</sup> I am torn between the two: I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far;

<sup>24</sup> but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body.

<sup>25</sup> Convinced of this, I know that I will remain, and I will continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith,

<sup>26</sup> so that through my being with you again your boasting in Christ Jesus will abound on account of me.
